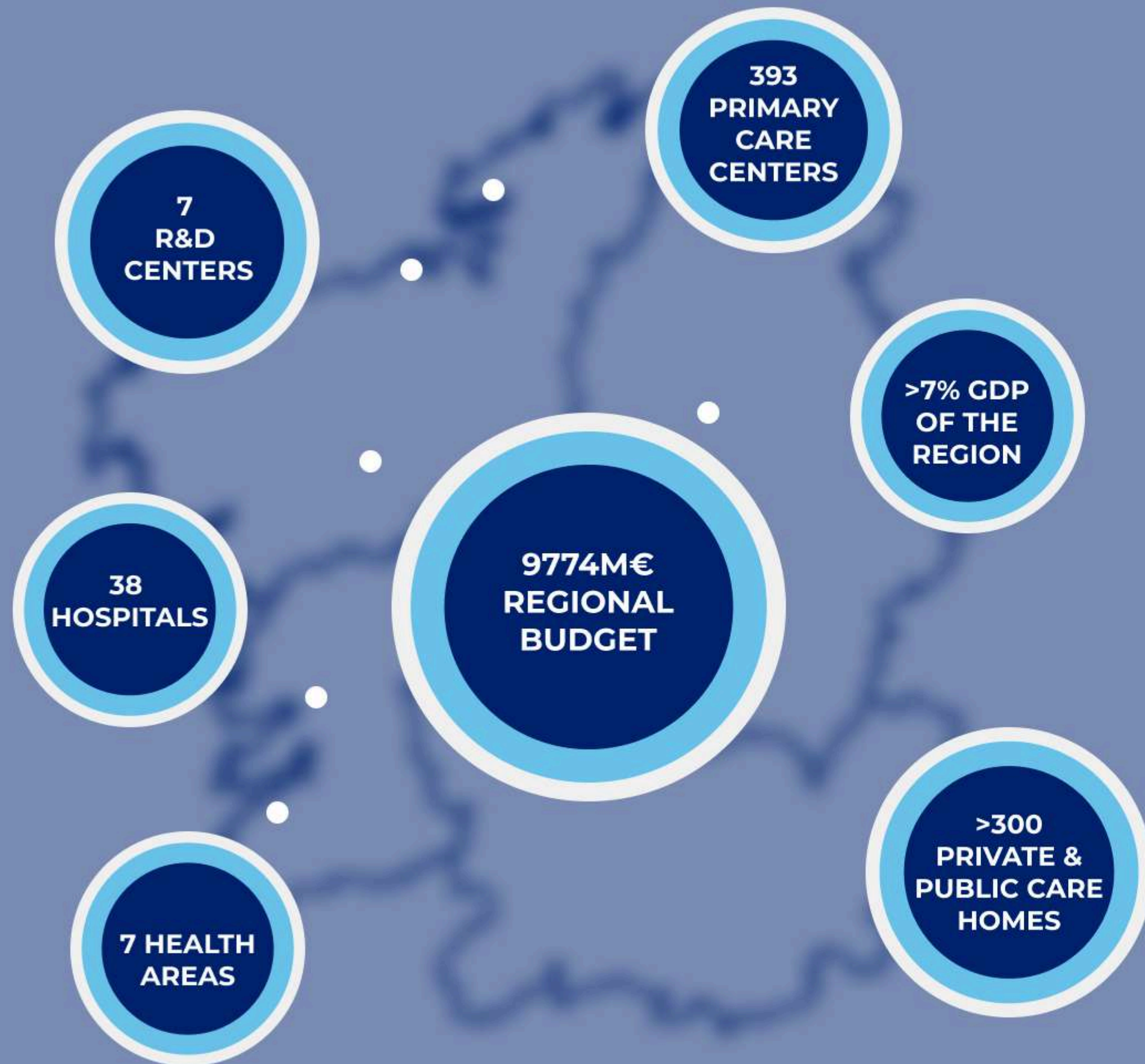

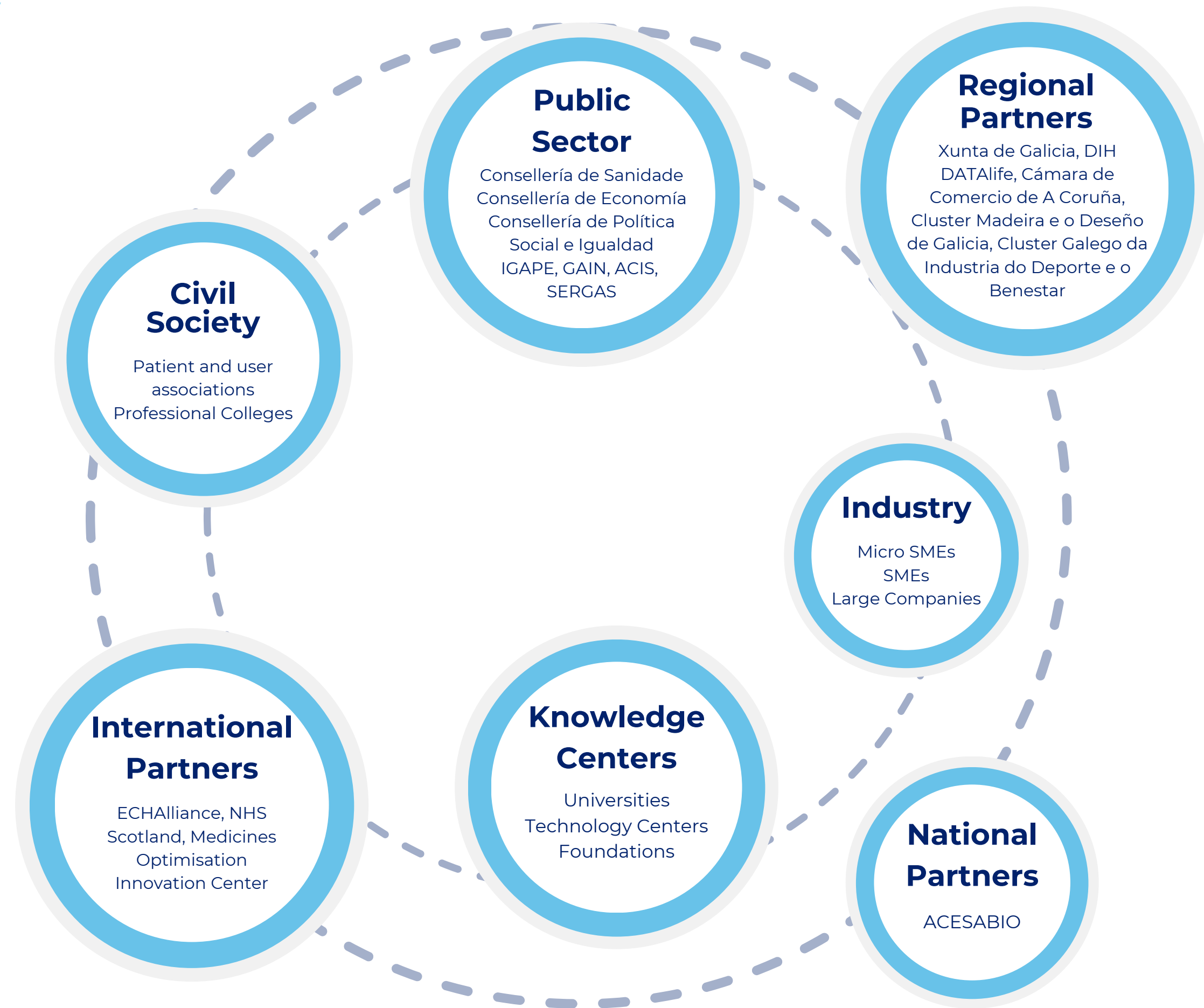

Aware of the importance of energy efficiency and reducing the carbon footprint in the Galician healthcare system, this sector has led the circular economy strategy and actively participates in various greentech initiatives. **In this context, CSG and Viratec collaborate closely to drive joint projects that promote sustainability and innovation in the region.**
