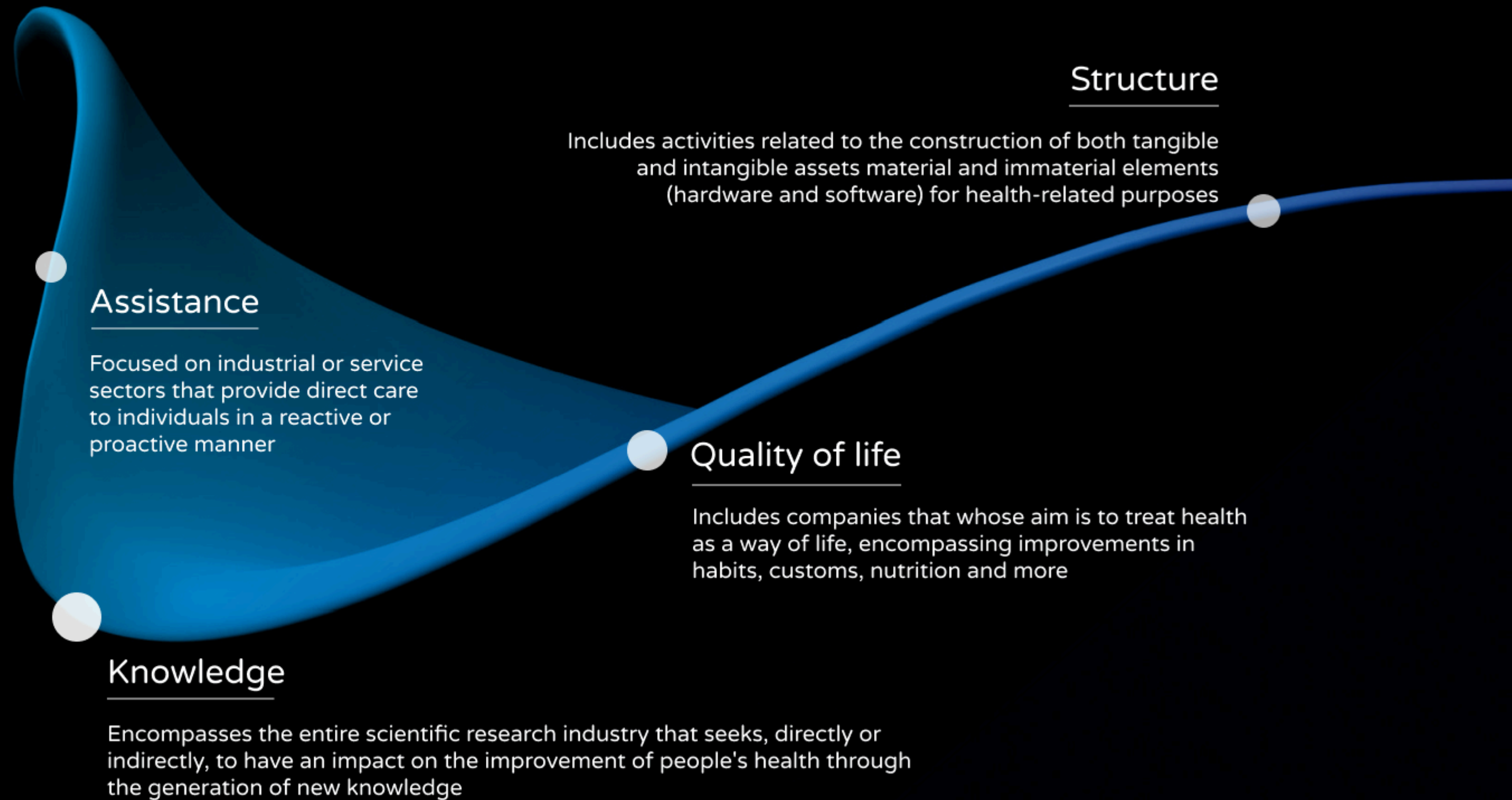

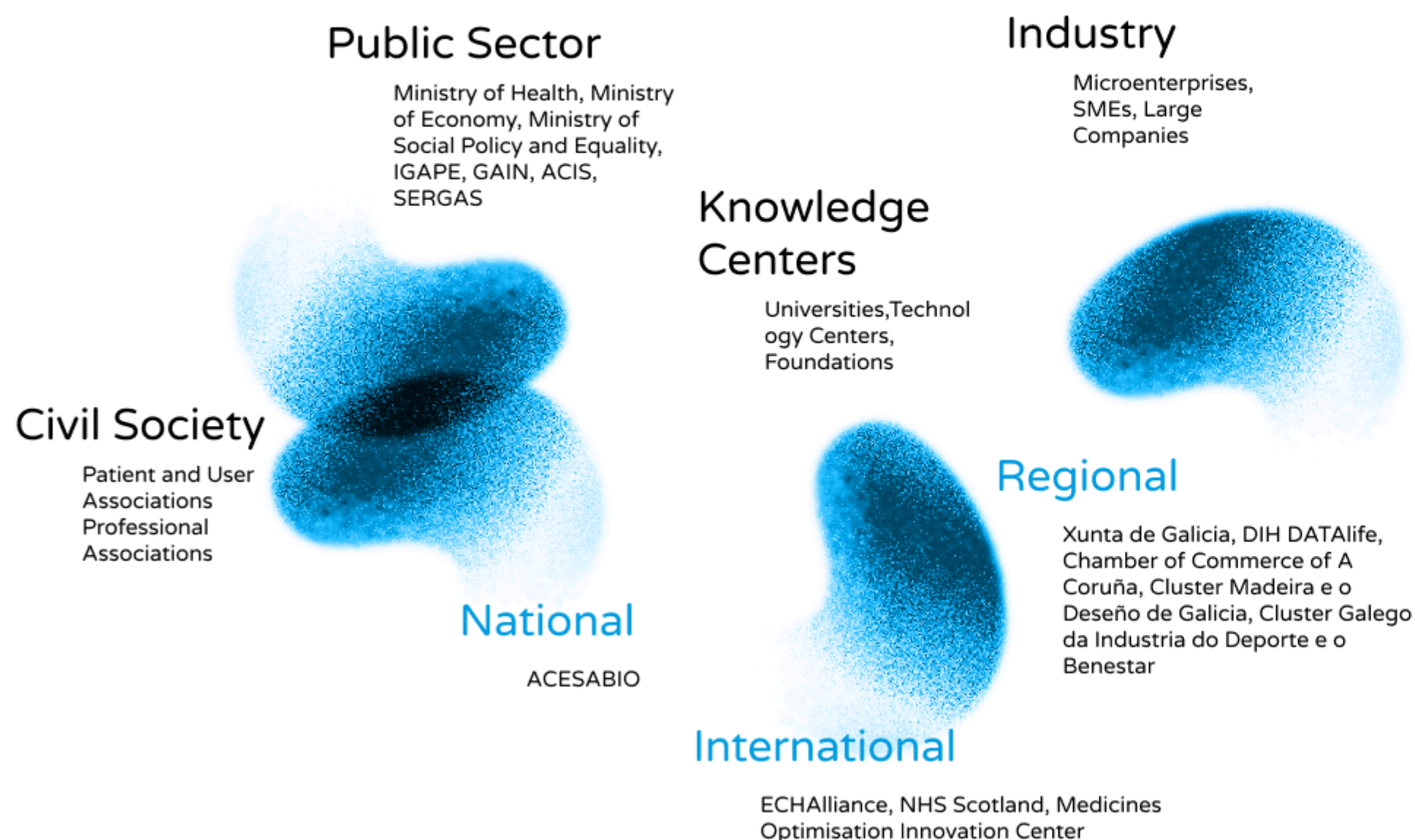

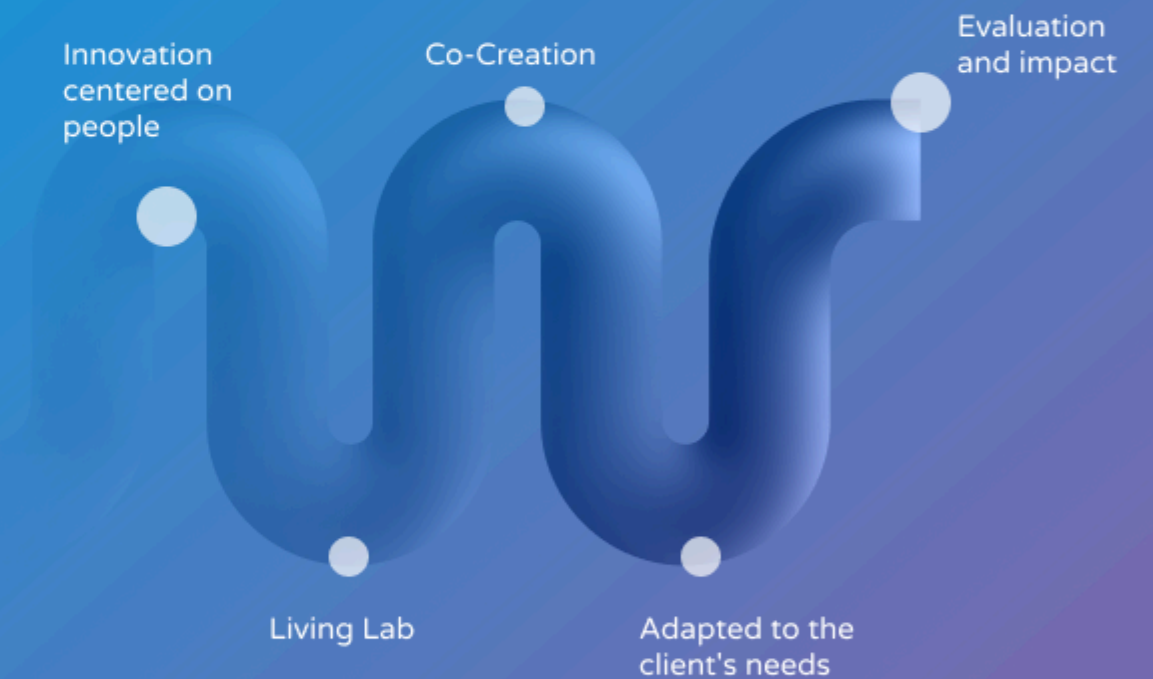

Learning Expeditions (LEX) or study missions are one of the main internationalization services offered by CSG. These missions can be direct, reverse or online, always with a common agenda that represents the CSG community and presents turnkey projects. The delegation is typically composed of regulators, R&D&I entities, industry representatives and patient associations. 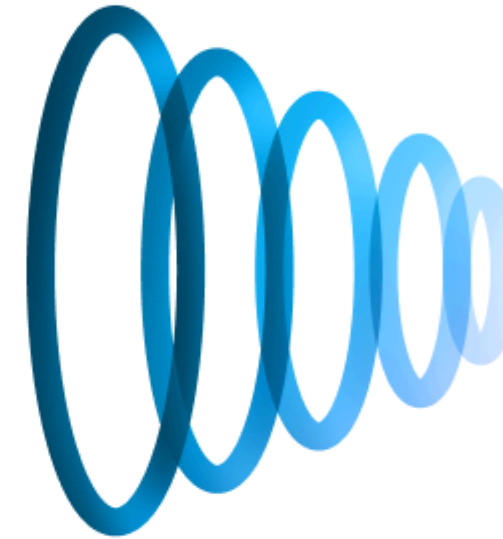
